## NOTIFICATION No. 30

The Academic Council vide its Resolution No. 28 dated 23.08.2024 duly approved by the Syndicate meeting vide its Resolution No. 16-1.10 dated 15.10.2024 has resolved to amend the process outlined in Notifications 3 (Ord.138 Point No.(g) (i) to (v), 15 (Ord.124 Point No.10.12), 20 (Ord. 124 Point No.10.13), and 24 (Ord. 124 Point No. 16.13) as following :

1. The candidate's thesis will be evaluated by the supervisor and ~~two~~ external examiners, selected by the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor from a list provided by the supervisor.
2. The open viva -voce of the research scholar to defend the thesis will be conducted by the Head of the Department provided the evaluation reports from the external examiner(s) are satisfactory and specifically recommend the award of a PhD degree.
3. If any of the external examiners reject the thesis in the evaluation report and do not recommend the award of a PhD degree, the University will send the thesis to another external examiner from the approved panel. The recommendations of the third external examiner will be final.
4. If any external examiner recommends a revision in their evaluation report, the researcher must revise the thesis as proposed by the examiner within a year, but not before three months. The revised thesis will be sent to the same external examiner who proposed the revisions to review the modifications and improvements, ensuring all necessary changes have been correctly made.
5. After, reviewing the thesis the external examiner will have only two options either to accept the thesis or to reject it. In the case of rejection, the examiner must provide a specific reason along with a detailed report.
6. In the event of rejection by the external examiner, the instructions outlined in point number 3 will be followed.
7. The University will send the thesis to another external examiner from the approved panel, and the viva -voce examination will be held only if the report of the last examiner

is satisfactory. If the report of the last examiner is also unsatisfactory, the thesis will be rejected, and the research scholar will be declared ineligible for the award of the degree.

8. The evaluation process will continue until either any two external examiners give their full approval and satisfactory report for the research work or any two external examiners give unsatisfactory reports and reject the research work.
